Since our last meeting, we had income of \$7,285 for November and December membership dues. During the same period, we spent \$7,287 mostly for the purchase of computer equipment for the classroom and open room totalling \$6,572 and the balance of approximately \$400 for other operating expenses. This leaves us with a checking account balance of \$34,459 and a CD of \$21,181 for total assets of \$55,640.

In the past thirty day 75 individuals have joined the Computer Club. Of those, 43 are new members and 32 are renewing members. Total membership is now 2,490. This compares with 2,187 members on March 15, 2021, an increase of 303 members.

We continue to need instructors for classes. We will have an Education Committee meeting March 22, 2022 at Hidden Cypress right after the Staff Meeting.
