Treasurer's Report

Our opening balance for January was \$35,193. During the month, we had an income of \$8,013.00 and expenses of \$1,190. Membership dues collected for the period were \$5,485, and education classes provided \$2,215 during the period. Expenses were predominantly spent in the area of software subscriptions, which amounted to \$523, and printing supplies, which amounted to \$365. The closing balance for the month was \$42,016.

Our \$20,000 CD matured in January, and we received interest in the amount of \$580. We rolled the full amount over in another 5% CD for 6 months. I would like to ask the board to consider putting another \$10,000 into a CD for 6 months. I believe we have that excess cash available.
